

Shmu ONE DAY MUSIC CHALLENGE


Ever fancied a day in a recording studio to record your own track?

Come and join us this summer for shmu's One Day Music Challenge. Work with our team of professional musicians and learn how to write and record a brand-new song – all in one day!

If you are of secondary school age and live in Tillydrone, Woodside, Torry, Middlefield, Seaton, Northfield or Cummings Park and are interested in making and/or recording music, this session will give you a taster of what goes into the process and show you how much fun it can be.

Throughout the day you will be supported to work in a group to create a piece of music from scratch; learning all the basics of lyric writing, music production and recording – and at the end of the day, sit back and listen to what you've created together.

- Use industry standard recording equipment
- Work with experienced musicians
- Work as a team to produce a piece of music
- Record the finished piece of music and take part in the editing process
